In a recent letter from the Heritage Foundation, they reported the following:

When Congress was negotiating with President Obama last January about the Fiscal Cliff, the President said "We don't have a spending problem....We have a health-care problem.

In February, House Minority leader Nancy Pelosi said "It is almost a false argument to say we

have a spending problem, we have a budget-deficit problem. They further reported that in that same

month Congressman Steny Hoyer, said "the Country has a paying-for problem.

The Internal Revenue Service stored 22,486 items of unusued furniture in a warehouse at an annual cost of \$862,000.

Federally subsidized Amtrak lost \$84.5 million on its food and beverage services in 2011, and \$833.8 million over the past 10 years. It has never broke evewn on these services.

Too many swallow the "balanced approach" that President Obama and the liberal leaders in Congress propose. That means more taxes now and promised spending cuts in the future that never materialize. The liberals never get enough taxes to satisfy the, and they always pretend the country will fall apart if a single dollar is cut from the budget.
