Now, farmers, dispensary owners, transporters and others will now have to start operating like a business.

They don't have to be a non-profit. AB 266 now allows a for-profit status that will extend to individuals, partnerships, corporations, business trusts, etc. Under the definition of "person"; likewise, applicants no longer need to be patients.

That means obtaining all of the necessary paperwork to become locally licensed first, then once approved can apply for a state license.

My advice, hire a lawyer and/or consultant who knows how to maneuver through this new process.

You now have to obtain business liability insurance, workers compensation insurance and transporters insurance if you're going to deliver.

Will this put an end to the black market? In my opinion, no it will not.

But, Cannabis will be the shot in the arm our County needs.
