Especially You, where my first mother-in-law resided until her passing, was very clean, and Alder Bay, where our Barbershop group has done Christmas caroling, and Timber Ridge, which is an assisted living facility, have several people whom I know living there and are very happy. There are a number of other facilities around that I

am not familiar with, but there is quite an inspection regimen they all have to pass.*//That brings me to the current mess involving the rest homes that are being threatened with closing ~~by the State~~. My son is in charge of the cooking in one of them, and he was told not to worry by the manager, I think I would worry anyway. The thought of moving people to far away or otherwise unfavorable
