The main stream media is not only the enemy of the American people it is also a destroyer of our freedoms. How can we the people know that this statement is a fact? We must first understand one absolute truth about our form of government. Every day the major media declares that our form of government is a democracy. The truth is our form of government is a Republic. When Americans say the pledge of allegiance they all recite: "*and to the Republic for which it (the American flag) stands.*" Our State flag reads: **CALIFORNIA REPUBLIC**. Article IV Section 4 in the Constitution guarantees every state within this Union shall be a Republic.

At first, rule by the people might sound correct; however, would you want your automobile to be fixed by majority rule? Mechanics have manuals they follow. The Constitution is the people's manual, however, you must read it and demand Constitutional Law!

The word democracy is not found in the Constitution and the word democracy is not found in any of our fifty State Constitutions. However, the word democracy is found in the Communist Manifesto. Karl Marx stated in the Communist

Manifesto: *"The first step in the Communist Revolution is to win the battle for democracy."* Communism is defined as total government control.

Under our Republic with rule by Constitutional law we the people have certain unalienable rights that cannot be taken by majority vote or the government. Unalienable and inalienable both mean that which cannot be alienated from the people.

The best source for understanding the Constitution is the Federalist Papers written by Alexander Hamilton, John Jay and James Madison.

James Madison, who is rightly known as the *"Father of the Constitution,"* wrote in the Federalist, number 10; *". . . democracies have ever been spectacles of turbulence and contention; have ever been found incompatible with personal security, or the rights of property; and have in general been short in their lives as they are violent in their deaths."*

Look at the violence in the streets and schools of America. The major media is destroying our freedoms by making the people believe they live in a democracy where the loudest and meanest voice rules. To protect your freedoms we the people must be united under our Constitutional Republic with rule by Constitutional Law not mob rule.
